FEAST OF SAINT JOHN VIANNEY

Today is the feast of St John Vianney, marking 165 years since his death in 1859. Since our church of Parkdale East is named in his honour, liturgically his feast is celebrated in that church as a Solemnity - the highest of the three classes of feast days, outranking a Sunday of Ordinary Time. So in St John Vianney's Church, the readings and prayers today are those of the Saint, not of the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time.



This afternoon we fittingly have at St John Vianney's our celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for candidates from Year Six at St John Vianney's Primary School.

We welcome Bishop Tony Ireland who will confer the Sacrament, and pray for all the children who are to be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

St Jean-Baptiste-Marie Vianney, known as the Curé of Ars, was born in Dardilly near Lyon in France on 8 May 1786. Due to the persecutions of the anti-Catholic French Revolution, over the 1790s his family practised their faith in secret, attending illegal Masses at distant farmhouses. In 1806 Vianney sought an education with Abbé Bailey in a nearby village. Drafted into Napoleon's armies in 1809, he deserted, living over a year in hiding. He struggled with his studies, especially Latin, and on

first attempt failed the entrance exam for the seminary at Lyon. Bailey persuaded church authorities that his great piety could compensate for his lack of theoretical knowledge, and he was ordained priest in 1815.

In 1818 he was appointed Parish Priest (Curé) of the village of Ars, 25 km north of Lyon. The Revolution had led to religious ignorance and indifference, but the Curé revitalised the Faith in his parish with dedication – burning with charity, firm in rooting out vices, ardent in prayer and penance, with special love of Eucharistic adoration and devotion to Mary Immaculate.

He founded a home for destitute girls; every day he gave catechetical instruction in the church, eventually to large crowds. His reputation for holiness spread across France and beyond, and by the 1850s, 20,000 pilgrims were coming to Ars annually; he would spend 16-18 hours a day hearing confessions, showing supernatural knowledge in his spiritual direction.

The holy Curé died on 4 August 1859; his body was found incorrupt in 1904 (a miracle that has occurred with many Saints and Beati). He was beatified by Pope St Pius X in 1905, and Pope Pius XI canonised him in 1925, naming him Patron Saint of Parish Priests in 1929. Pope St John XXIII marked his centenary in 1959 by the Encyclical *Sacerdotii Nostri Primordia*; and for his 150th anniversary Pope Benedict XVI proclaimed 2009-10 the 'Year of the Priest'.
